An application for a new Church of England Secondary School in Sutton, an 11-19 6FE co-educational school, will be submitted to the Department for Education in November 2018.

The new school will be highly inclusive, have a distinctive Christian character and will offer its students the opportunity to grow and develop within a broad and balanced curriculum framework underpinned by Christian values.

It will be operated by the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education (SDBE) multi-academy trust, alongside its existing family of schools. As there is currently no Church of England secondary co-educational provision in the area, this -funded school will offer parents greater choice.

Subject to approval by the Secretary of State, the Sutton CofE Secondary School will open with 180 Year 7 students, growing each year to a full capacity of 1,150 including a sixth form.
